

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Ordinance No. 18-29 Passed 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 2018

### AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to reduce the appropriations to the Fire Levy, Opera House Project, Sewer Separation Project, and the Water Tank Painting Project, and the Waterline Replacement Project due to the fact that these funds did not receive the amount of money in 2017 as originally anticipated;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The appropriations to the General Fund be reduced by \$480,851.96 in the line item entitled Other Capital Outlay, (1000-730-590).

**Section 2.** The appropriations to the Street M & R Fund be reduced by \$60,000 in the line item entitled Other Capital Outlay, (2011-620-590).

**Section 3.** The appropriations to the Opera House Project be reduced by \$835,219.24 in the line item entitled Other Capital Outlay, (4203-800-500).

**Section 4.** The appropriations to the Waterline Replacement Project be reduced by \$205,558.05 in the line item entitled Other Capital Outlay, (5704-800-500-3000).

**Section 5.** The appropriations to the Mayor’s Agency Fund be reduced by \$1,468.40 in the line item entitled Other Fines and Forfeitures, (9901-720-690).

**Section 6.** That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 7.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelville, Ohio, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
