## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 11-14      Passed    10<sup>th</sup>      day of    May                    2011

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO PREPARE AND FILE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO PLACE A RENEWAL LEVY OF TWO-TENTHS OF ONE PERCENT (2.0 MILLS) FOR STREET REPAIR AND RESURFACING ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Street levy for 2.0 mills that the Village of McConnelsville has for the resurfacing and repair of streets and alleys within the Village of McConnelsville is due to expire at the end of the year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village needs to make repairs, maintain and improve its existing roadways; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of the Village of McConnelsville to submit the question of a levy to a vote of the people; and

**WHEREAS**, an emergency exists effecting the public health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelsville.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of McConnelsville, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** The County Auditor prepare necessary information for the Village of McConnelsville to place a renewal levy for two (2) mills for the purpose of resurfacing and repair of streets and alleys within the Village of McConnelsville to the Village residents for a period of 5 years on the November, 2011 ballot.

**SECTION 2.** An emergency exists affecting the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelsville because there is insufficient time to do three separate readings before the deadline to have this matter placed on the November 2011 ballot.
