## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 11-17                      Passed this 21<sup>st</sup>                      day of                      June                      2011

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT, DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF A RENEWAL LEVY EXCEEDING SAID RATE, DIRECTING THE CERTIFICATION THEREOF TO THE MORGAN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF THE LEVY TO THE ELECTORS OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of McConnelville has determined that the amount of taxes that may be levied by law at the maximum rate authorized by #5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code on the taxable property in the Village of McConnelville will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount of funding necessary for the resurfacing and repair of the streets and alleys in the Village;

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of McConnelville has determined that it is in the interest of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village that the present levy therefore be renewed for the tax years 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016;

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of McConnelville has determined that it is necessary in the interest of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of McConnelville that the question be submitted to the voters in the precincts of McConnelville A, McConnelville B and McConnelville C at the next regular election as to whether the present tax levy for street and alley resurfacing and repair presently levied upon the residents of the Village of McConnelville at a rate exceeding the maximum rate authorized by #5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code without a vote of the electors should be renewed; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, COUNTY OF MORGAN, STATE OF OHIO**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The question of whether the present tax levy for the resurfacing and repair of the streets and alleys in the Village of McConnelville presently levied upon the residents of the Village of McConnelville at a rate in excess of the maximum rate authorized by #5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code without a vote of the electors for the purpose of generating sufficient funding for the resurfacing and repair of streets and alleys within the Village of McConnelville should be renewed and shall be certified to the Morgan County Board of Elections for submission to the voters in the precincts of McConnelville A, McConnelville B and McConnelville C at the next regular election.

**SECTION 2.** The tax levy referred to in Section 1 hereinabove shall be at the rate of two (2) mills on each dollar, which amounts to Twenty Cents (\$.20) for each One Hundred Dollars of tax valuation of the taxable property within the Village of McConnelville in excess of the rate authorized by #5705.19 of the Ohio Revised Code, and shall be effective for a period of five (5) years commencing with the tax year 2011.
