## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

### A RESOLUTION REDUCING THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to reduce the appropriations to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund; Fire Levy Fund; Unclaimed Monies Fund; and, the Phase I Kennebec West Sewer Separation Capital Project, due to the fact that these funds did not receive the amount of money in 2011 as originally anticipated;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** The appropriations to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund be reduced by \$2,300.00 in the line item entitled Capital Outlay, (2011-620-590).

**Section 2.** The appropriations to the Fire Levy Fund be reduced by \$1,900.00 in the line item entitled Contributions to Other Organizations, (2902-120-650).

**Section 3.** The appropriations to the Unclaimed Monies Fund be reduced by \$854.14 in the line item entitled Other Financing Uses, (9101-990-990).

**Section 4.** The appropriations to the Phase I Kennebec West Sewer Separation Capital Project be reduced by \$284,100.00 in the line item entitled Other Capital Outlay, (4201-800-560).

**Section 5.** That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 6.** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelsville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
