### A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE:

**Section 1:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled General Fund Recreation Capital Outlay (1000-310-590) the sum of \$6,000 from the line item entitled General Fund Swimming Pool Capital Outlay (1000-340-590).

**Section 2:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled General Fund Recreation Capital Outlay (1000-310-590) the sum of \$5,000 from the line item entitled General Fund Provide and Maintain Parks Capital Outlay (1000-320-590).

**Section 3:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled General Fund Recreation Capital Outlay (1000-310-590) the sum of \$21,500 from the line item entitled General Fund Lands and Buildings Capital Outlay (1000-730-590).

**Section 3:** That the purpose of the transfer is to provide the necessary monies to pay for the Recreation Boat Docks Project as the Grant monies to be received on this project are reimbursable.

**Section 4:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
