## VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE

Resolution No. 15-20 Passed 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November 2015

### A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN GENERAL FUND

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE:

**Section 1:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled Income Tax Administration Contractual Services (1000-755-399) the sum of \$500.00 from the line item entitled Tax Administration Training Services (1000-755-348).

**Section 2:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled Income Tax Administration Contractual Services (1000-755-399) the sum of \$1,000.00 from the line item entitled Tax Administration Capital Outlay (1000-755-590).

**Section 3:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled Lands and Buildings Supplies and materials (1000-730-490) the sum of \$10,000.00 from the line item entitled Lands and Buildings Capital Outlay (1000-730-590).

**Section 4:** That there be transferred within the General Fund to the line item entitled Deposits Refunded (1000-760-610) the sum of \$5,000.00 from the line item entitled Lands and Buildings Capital Outlay (1000-730-590).

**Section 5:** That the purpose of the transfer is to provide the necessary monies to pay for furnishings and supplies for the Village Council Chambers; Contractual Services with Creative Microsoft Incorporated for annual support in the Tax Office; and additional unexpected Tax Refunds.

**Section 6:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 6:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelsville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
