Resolution No. 16-24 Passed 1st day of November 2016

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN GENERAL, STREET, WATER AND SEWER FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MCCONNELSVILLE:

Section 1: That there be transferred within the General Fund to the following line items:

- Police Department Workers' Compensation (1000-110-225) the sum of \$1,884.49
- Swimming Pool Workers' Compensation (1000-340-225) the sum of \$259.35
- Parking Facilities Workers' Compensation (1000-660-225) the sum of \$129.17
- Mayor Workers' Compensation (1000-710-225) the sum of \$64.08
- Legislative Workers' Compensation (1000-715-225) the sum of \$194.26
- Mayor's Court Workers' Compensation (1000-720-225) the sum of \$64.08
- Fiscal Officer Workers' Compensation (1000-725-225) the sum of \$454.54
- Lands and Buildings Workers' Compensation (1000-730-225) the sum of \$64.08
- Village Administrator Workers' Compensation (1000-735-225) the sum of \$129.17
- Solicitor Workers' Compensation (1000-750-225) the sum of \$129.17
- Income Tax Administration Workers' Compensation (1000-755-225) the sum of \$129.17

The total of this transfer is \$3,501.56 and will be transferred from the line item entitled Deposits Refunded (1000-760-610).

Section 2: That there be transferred within the Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Fund to the line item entitled Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Workers' Compensation (2011-620-225) the sum of \$259.36 from the line item entitled Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Electricity (2011-620-311).

Section 3: That there be transferred within the Water Fund to the following line items:

- Administration Workers' Compensation (5101-531-225) the sum of \$129.17
- Billing Workers' Compensation (5101-532-225) the sum of \$194.26
- Pumping Workers' Compensation (5101-535-225) the sum of \$780.02

The total of this transfer is \$1,103.45 and will be transferred from the line item entitled Pumping Engineering (5101-535-346).

Section 4: That there be transferred within the Sewer Fund to the following line items:

- Administration Workers' Compensation (5201-541-225) the sum of \$129.17
- Billing Workers' Compensation (5201-542-225) the sum of \$194.26
- Pumping Workers' Compensation (5201-543-225) the sum of \$519.68
- Other Sanitary Sewers Workers' Compensation (5201-549-225) the sum of \$780.02

The total of this transfer is \$1,623.13 and will be transferred from the line item entitled Pumping Capital Outlay (5201-543-590).

Section 5: That the purpose of the transfers are to provide the necessary monies to pay for the 2017 Workers' Compensation.

Section 6: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of McConnelsville, Ohio, and therefore this Resolution shall be in full force and in effect immediately after its passage.
